EUREMnext



About

EUREM is a standardised European EnergyManager training program comprising courses, self-learning and practical work, combined with access to a European alumni network for continued knowledge exchange.

During the course, on average, each EnergyManager develops measures with savings potentials of 600 MWh/a for their company. **Participants learn to describe the technical and financial aspects of their measures in a standardised and concise way, to facilitate decisions at management level. On average about 75% of these measures get implemented and further ones are carried out later on.**

Goal

The goal of the program is to train employees to recognize the potential for energy savings, set specific objectives and implement the necessary measures for saving energy and money. Based on that, the participants make its individual energy concept, which among other things represents part of the final exam and the conditions for obtaining an internationally recognized EUREM EnergyManager certificate.

Average EUREMnext energy concept savings figures:

Structure

European EnergyManager Program on average lasts six to eight months and takes place in six three day modules from 8:30 a.m. to 5:30 p.m. The content consists of sixteen mandatory topics discussed by experts and representatives of renowned companies. The participants invest 136 hours during lectures and 84 individual hours for their energy concepts.

The beginning of this years EUREMnext programme in BiH is scheduled for the first weeks of May and will be carried out in a hybrid (online and offline) mode.

First generation of energy managers

The first generation of EUREMnext managers was a great success. At the recently held 10th international EUREM conference in Athens, the engineer of the Lukavac Cement Factory Emir Ćilimković won the prestigious "EUREM 2020" award for the third best energy saving project in the competition of a total of 40 submitted works from 27 countries.
