- impressive annual traffic volume per 1 km

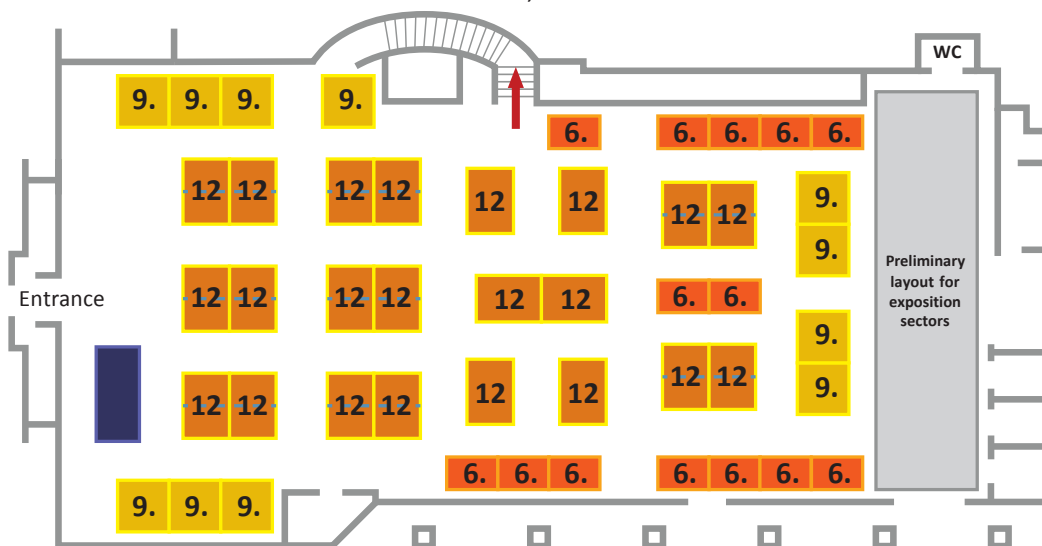

According to the investment scenario, Ukraine needs around **69,000 new freight cars** and almost **300 locomotives** by 2020. In addition, up to 55,000 cars and 520 locomotives are to be repaired and upgraded.

The successive technical and technological modernization will allow Ukrainian railways to become a strong player on the Eurasian overland cargo transportation market due to favourable transit location, access to 18 maritime ports of the Azov-Black Sea basin, developed network of railways and huge cargo potential.
