The Erasmus+ DERHE project successfully launched with a kick-off meeting in Ljubljana, bringing together European partners to advance digital education readiness in higher education

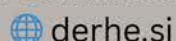
DERHE Project Kick-off Meeting Held in Ljubljana

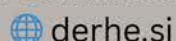
Successful Study Visit to KU Leuven Campus Ghent

In June 2024, the DERHE project team gathered in Ghent for an engaging study visit hosted by KU Leuven Technology Campus. The event brought together project partners to strengthen collaboration and explore innovative approaches to digital education. Participants toured KU Leuven's advanced labs, experienced interactive AR/VR course digitalization demonstrations, and attended workshops on project management and teaching methods, focusing on industry collaboration and online learning.

A key highlight of the visit was the Lean Office Game session, organized by the Lean Learning Academy, which provided practical tools for improving efficiency in education. This study visit underscored the DERHE project's commitment to advancing digital education readiness across Europe through collaboration and innovation.

Working Package 2 Successfully Launched: Key Topics Defined for Training in Western Balkan Universities

The University of Ljubljana and KU Leuven will prepare training materials to equip university staff with innovative skills, ensuring readiness to meet modern educational and industrial challenges.
